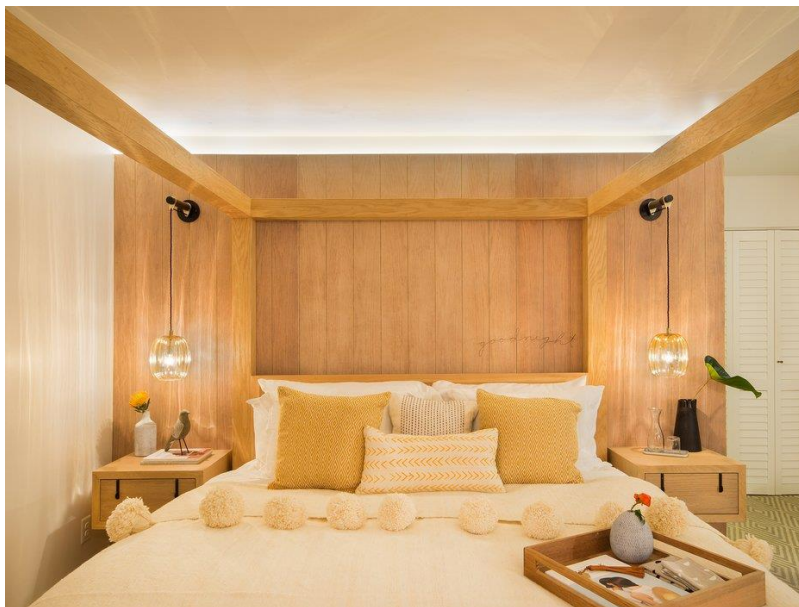


The Hotel Report: Jackson Hole's Hottest New Hotel; The Latest from Cabo and Southern California

Your weekly roundup of the best of what's new, what's coming up, and what we can't wait for in the world of hotels.

INCOMING

Just in time for Wyoming's glorious summer season, Hotel Jackson opens next month in Jackson Hole, a luxury boutique property with spectacular views of the Grand Tetons. The design displays a modern and refreshing twist on the western theme seen so often in the region, using reclaimed barn wood, leather, and painted metal in its 58 guest rooms and common spaces.

THE RE-DO

Esperanza, An Auberge Resort in Cabo San Lucas, is preparing to open its doors again in June after a big redesign to all 57 beachside rooms, and renovated touches to the restaurant (Cocina del Mar), swimming pool, and spa. As part of the enhancements, local artisans were commissioned to create original furnishings and artwork.

ON OUR RADAR

Elsewhere in Cabo (and also debuting in June): Work is almost finished on Thompson Hotel's newest property, The Cape, located on Monuments Beach, a very popular surf site. It comes with 161 guestrooms, an infinity pool with swim-up bar, and a restaurant from Enrique Olvera, of NYC's Cosme and Pujol in Mexico City.

WEEKEND GETAWAY

In Santa Barbara's wine country, The Landsby opens this week in Solvang, about two hours north of Los Angeles. The 41 rooms follow a Scandinavian design philosophy (inspired by the town's history—it was settled by immigrants from Denmark) and the restaurant, Mad & Vin, will serve up a modern, California take on Danish cuisine.
